

Important Notification

INOV8 International is proud to have completed testing and re-certification in 2007 of our products by Intertek ETL-Semko to all safety standards required in the United States and Canada. Prior to ETL, INOV8 products were tested and listed by UL of Canada under file #CMP239 and by PFS Corporation under test report #90-39. In 1996 INOV8 requested UL of Canada to make two changes to our file: a change of address and the model numbers on furnaces from the A10, A20 & A45 to F125, F200 & F450, respectively. Unbeknown to INOV8, the model numbers were never changed. UL's failure to change the model numbers was made worse when coupled with an improper notification from a UL engineer that INOV8 should use the "cUL" logo rather than the "ULC" logo. Despite UL causing both errors and overlooking them for 12 years while making quarterly onsite inspections and accepting our listing fees, UL is notifying the public that INOV8 furnaces are not safe, to appease a competitor. This is absolutely not true. If you believe you have a label with an improper logo, contact INOV8 immediately.

INOV8 has always adhered to the highest safety standards in product design, testing, selection of safety controls, the installation, application and support of our products. Do not be misled by a competitors misrepresentations to the contrary.
